ORDER RE DISCOVERY

Arguments relating to the State's Motion for Discovery were presented to the Court on June 2, 2023. For the reasons stated on the record, the Court hereby GRANTS the State's motion. The discovery relating to the photos and/or impression of the Defendant's feet are to be taken in accordance with the protocol attached to the State's Motion, and must be completed within 14 days from the date of this Order, unless reasonably extended by agreement of both parties.

Defense counsel must be given prior notice of the date and time when the work will be undertaken, and defense counsel shall be allowed to be present while any such photography or impressions of the Defendant's feet are taken.

The State is further ordered to supplement any expert designation relating to this additional evidence within 45 days from the date of this Order. Any additional designation shall also include the subject matter on which the expert is expected to testify, the substance of the facts and opinions to which

the expert is expected to testify and a summary of the grounds for each opinion.
