NOW COMES Defendant, by and through undersigned counsel, and hereby moves this Court for the entry of an order concerning discovery, and states in support as follows:


1. Defendant has been charged with: theft by unauthorized taking, bribery in official and political matters.
2. Maine Rule of Unified Criminal Procedure 16(d)(4) provides that:

If an expert witness whom the state intends to call in any proceedings has not prepared a report of examination or tests, the court, upon motion, may order that the expert prepare and the attorney for the state serve a report stating the subject matter on which the expert is expected to testify, the substance of the facts to which the expert is expected to testify and a summary of the expert's opinions and the grounds for each opinion.

3. In the case before the Court, should the State call any expert witness at any proceedings, Defendant requests such a report.
