**PRELIMINARY SCHEDULING
ORDER FOR PHASE I TRIAL**

The Supreme Judicial Court on May 3, 2024 denied the Defendants’ Appeal of this Court’s interlocutory order of February 27, 2024 denying preliminary approval of a proposed settlement in this case. A scheduling conference was held by Zoom on May 13, 2024 during which the Court and counsel for the parties discussed the future course of proceedings. The purpose of this Order is to impose a preliminary scheduling order and discovery deadline for the Phase I trial.

Accordingly, the Court orders that **September 13, 2024** is the deadline for discovery for the Phase I trial. The Court will entertain requests to alter this deadline after the Court issues a Decision on Plaintiffs’ Motion for Leave to Amend and Supplement Complaint. Depending on that Decision, the discovery deadline may be extended for good cause shown. In the Court’s Decision, the Court will provide notice of a scheduling conference with counsel for all parties who remain in the case, and other scheduling deadlines will be set at that conference.


