ORDER ESTABLISHING COURSE OF APPEAL

Secretary of State et al.

Alex Titcomb et al. have appealed from the order of the Superior Court (Cumberland County, *O'Neil, J.*), entered on June 13, 2025, determining that the Secretary of State's wording of the ballot question for the citizen initiative entitled "An Act to Require an Individual to Present Photographic Identification for the Purpose of Voting" is understandable and not misleading. The appeal is governed by 21-A M.R.S. § 905 (2025) and the Maine Rules of Appellate Procedure. The Clerk of the Law Court has docketed the appeal under Law Court docket number Cum-25-284. The clerk of the Superior Court has transmitted the record to the Clerk of the Law Court.

It is ORDERED as follows:

1. Any interested person or organization may file a brief as an amicus curiae pursuant to M.R. App. P. 7A(e) without consent of the parties or separate leave of the Court.

2. The parties and any amici must file their briefs and submit the required electronic versions of their briefs, and the appellants must file the appendix and an electronic version of the appendix, on or before **June 27**, **2025**, **at 3:00 p.m.** The provisions of M.R. App. P. 7A(c) do not apply to this appeal; the parties must file both the electronic versions and the paper copies on or before June 27 at 3:00 p.m.

4. No reply briefs or other briefing is permitted.

The Court will hold oral argument in this appeal on Tuesday, July
2025, at 10:00 a.m. at the Cumberland County Courthouse in Portland.
